Applicants must be grades 8-11 (current school year) and be a resident of Idaho's Treasure Valley. There is a \$5 fee for Student Scholarship applicants.

Applicants may sing 1-2 vocal selections, adding up to no more than 8 minutes (including introduction).

Vocal selections must be completely memorized. Classical pieces, such as art songs and arias, are strongly encouraged.

Applicants must provide their own accompanist; instrumental tracks are not acceptable.

Applicants must provide 3 physical copies of sheet music for the judges' use only. Photocopies are acceptable and will be destroyed immediately following the audition.

Scholarship winners will be awarded at the Musettes' Spring Concert on Friday, April 19 at 7:00pm. Scholarship applicants are expected to attend this concert to receive their results. The top 3 winners will also be expected to attend the concert the following day, Saturday, April 20 at 2:00pm (so we can highlight your accomplishment again!)

Winners may choose their own vocal teachers. Teachers must invoice The Musettes directly for lesson payment. Scholarship money must be used by June of the following year or be forfeited.

Winners may be asked to sing as a special guest at a Musettes' seasonal concert.
